We have been celebrating all things science at Kensington Primary School this week. We kicked our week off with a science themed assembly introducing this year's theme of 'Change and Adaptation'. The children then paired up with other children from a different year group to work collaboratively on designing an animal adapted to a specific habitat. We had artic sloths, desert beluga whales and sea tigers, to name just a few!



All classes enjoyed sharing their scientific knowledge with our families with our stay and science events returning for another year. We considered the skills required to be a successful scientist and embraced how anyone can work to be a scientist, celebrating a wide range of scientists from diverse backgrounds and their achievements.

On Thursday and Friday 3C and 3D respectively visited Croxteth Farm. The children are studying agriculture in Geography and this was an opportunity to use their scientific vocabulary in context whilst enjoying themselves with the animals and looking at pastoral farming first hand. 3S will be going on Tuesday of next week.

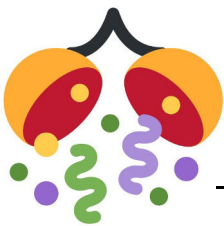

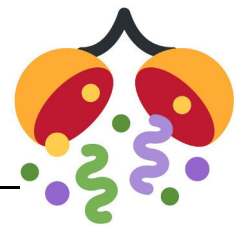
