Dear parents and carers,

This week the weather has been so lovely and the impact that has on the mood of the children is brilliant. They seem much more awake and ready to learn.

On Monday our new trainee teachers started in our school. They will work here until late in the summer term. It is great that the trainee's get to learn in our school environment and experience teaching our wonderful children. It also means another adult in the classroom to give extra support!

3S went to Croxteth Hall and Country Park to visit the farm, they had been really looking forward to going as the other classes went last week. I asked the children about what they had learned about and it was clear that they were able to talk about agriculture. This is why they were going linking the trip to their opening world curriculum.

On Thursday Year 1 visited All Saints Church the children will be visiting a mosque very soon so that they can compare the two buildings, looking at how they are set out and what features are common to all churches and all mosques.

This week EYFS raised £60.50 selling decorated fairy cakes to raise money for the Pupil Panels chosen charity of Alder Hey. Key Stage 1 and 2 will be doing some fundraising events very soon so watch out for what they are planning.

As many of you know we have changed the safeguarding arrangements for breakfast club which means that children must sign into breakfast club before 8.20 to be able to play on the yard before school. Children who do not go to breakfast club must not climb over the wooden gates and fences to go on the yard and parents must not encourage this.

As many of you know it is Ramadan at the moment and we thought that it would be really good if like we could share in the celebrations once Eid arrives and we are therefore having a special menu on Tuesday 1st April and having small class parties where children can bring in some treats from home. School will provide drink and dates which are a traditional food used to break fasting. We hope you will all join in celebrating the diverse nature of our school.

Each and every day but particularly on a Friday, parents are picking their children up early from school. This is not always for a valid reason such as a hospital appointment which cannot be rearranged but due to parents having to go somewhere. Children are expected to attend school for the whole school session 8.50 am to 3.15pm EYFS and Key stage 1 and 3.25 for Key stage 2. All the time in school is valuable and contributes to the education of your child so it is very important that they stay to the end of the day. Recent research has shown a direct impact of poor attendance in primary and secondary school on the earnings your child has as an adult. I ask parents to think about the future impact of taking children out of school early unnecessarily.

This week's whole school attendance figure is 96.56%. The whole school attendance continues to improve and we are so thrilled as this means that children are not missing any of the exciting learning opportunities that we plan. Remember please contact school on your first day of absence as soon as possible. Well done to all those children who have been in school, on time, every day this week.

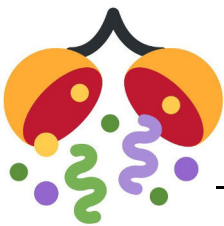

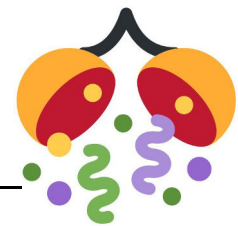


