<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="121 840 341 1218"> <p><u>The Stone Age</u> - period during which stone was widely used to make stone tools.</p>  </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="341 840 578 1218">  <p><u>Ancient Egyptians</u> wrote hieroglyphics on walls and on papyrus.</p> </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="578 840 875 1218"> <p><u>Ibn Battuta</u> - he spent nearly 30 years travelling. It is estimated he travelled nearly 70,000 miles.</p>  </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="875 840 1113 1365">  <p><u>William Caxton</u> - William Caxton brought the first printing press to England so books could be printed quickly and cheaply.</p> </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="1113 840 1350 1365"> <p><u>Queen Elizabeth I</u> - She became queen at the age of 25 and reigned from 1558 - 1603. Her reign was also referred to as the Golden Age.</p>  </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="1350 840 1647 1365">  <p><u>The Great Fire of London</u> - The fire was so big that it was called the Great Fire of London. The fire lasted four days, and burned down over 13,000 homes.</p> </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="1647 840 1914 1482"> <p><u>Queen Victoria</u> - was born on 24th May 1819, and became Britain's longest monarch, as she ruled for 63 years. She ruled over 400 million people in the British Empire.</p>  </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="1914 840 2181 1323">  <p><u>The Titanic</u> - The RMS Titanic was a British cruise ship that sank on April 15, 1912 during its first voyage from England to New York</p> </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="2181 840 2374 1407"> <p><u>Neil Armstrong</u> - in 1969 went aboard Apollo 11 and became the first man to walk on the moon.</p>  </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="2374 840 2537 1281">  <p><u>Tim Berners-Lee</u> - invented the World Wide Web.</p> </div>	<p>↑</p> <div data-bbox="2537 840 2730 1449"> <p><u>Helen Sharman</u> - the first Briton to train to become an astronaut.</p>  </div>
