WELCOME BACK!

I hope that you have all had a super summer with your children even if the weather was not as good as we would have hoped.

This week all the classes have focussed on the pastoral side of school, getting back into routines and understanding clearly the expectations inside and outside the classroom. It has been a time where they could get to know their new teachers and teaching assistants and to remember some of the things they may have forgotten over the summer.

It has been lovely to see all the children wearing their school uniform. The uniform we have is worn so that the children feel part of our community, a clear identity to show they belong. Remember there is preloved uniform available for those families who want it, please take advantage of the lower prices.

Some children have been seen wearing jewellery which is not allowed. The children are allowed to wear a wrist watch without internet connectivity and earrings that are studs or sleepers. All other jewellery will be asked to be removed and put in a labelled envelope and kept safe until home time where it should be taken home and not worn again in school.

Can I please remind parents about parking near to the school particularly on Brae Street and Bell Tower Lane. Last year there were several near misses and we would not want any child or parent hurt due to parking in the wrong place. The best idea is to park further away from school and walk the children in.

Finally, I want to remind you all about how important attendance at school is. This year it is not just a priority for school but also for the Liverpool City Region and nationally. Last year we had improved our attendance until several families decided to take holidays in term time or return to their home countries before the end of term. This led to a drop in our attendance which is very disappointing.

Children should be attending school every day unless they are ill or have an emergency appointment. No holidays will be authorised. We sent out term dates last term to ensure that they were available for any parents wanting to book their holidays so that no school would be missed. We have so many exciting things happening in school throughout the year and we would not want anyone to miss out.

We have also notified you all of the changes to the fixed penalty fine system and the more severe consequences attached to keeping your child off school unnecessarily.

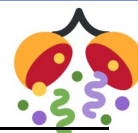
