On Monday the immunisation team was in school to deliver the flu vaccination to some of our children. Please contact your doctors if you would like to get your child immunised.

This will help to train up the next generation of teachers but also, it's an opportunity to have an extra adult in the class to offer our children support in the areas of the curriculum they find more challenging.

On Friday Year 1 visited Botanic Park as a Year group, this was to look at our local area, the children walked there from school. They did this very sensibly and had a fabulous time talking about what they saw.

We have had several matches for our football teams this week. The children are all doing really well at representing the school. It is lovely seeing the children coming back and sharing the match report. Keep going and let's hope we can win the league.

This week's whole school attendance figure is 94.64%. Unfortunately this is not as good as on last week. Please ensure that children are in school, on time, every day. We must keep striving for the target of 97%!

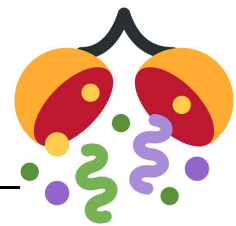
