Dear parents and carers,

This week we have welcomed parents into Stay and Read sessions in your children's class. I know that when children have their parents there, the children are always so pleased to be able to share this time together with their family members. We try to reinforce the importance of reading at all times. Being read to and reading for yourself are both super important to a child's development.

On Monday the year 4 children went on a trip to the Palm House to meet a poet who focussed on Black History Month. He read the children some of his work and told them stories. The children really enjoyed this simple celebration.

On Wednesday year 6 had a very special visitor indeed. They welcomed Doctor Diana a Mayan historian. She is a specialist in Mayan culture and she brought with her several artefacts for the children to look at and see in real life not just from pictures in books. The children were all fascinated and thrilled as Dr Diana appears in their Opening world text books that they have. Well done for all the fabulous questions that were asked.

Also, on Wednesday Reception started their visits to the Palm House and Sefton Park. They are focussing on the seasons as part of their understanding the world curriculum. The children were able to see the changes in colours of the leaves but also in the palm house where the temperature is controlled so the seasons do not affect the plants.

Unfortunately, this week's girls football match was called off due to the horrendous weather on Wednesday however the boys have got two games tonight against St Finbar's and Pleasant Street we wish them luck.

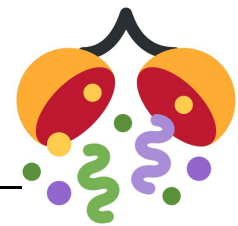
